DWP Department of Work and Pensions (Welfare Benefits)

You can apply for Universal Credit immediately.

For example, a family of Mother+2 children, living in Homes for Ukraine setting may be eligible for \sim £940/ month.

A National Insurance Number will also be issued once the benefits application is approved. And you this will be an important number you'll need while in UK – all UK citizens have it – used for benefits, banking, work, tax, etc.

To apply online you'll need:

- your bank account details
- an email address
- access to a phone

Child Benefit

If you have children under 16, you can also claim separate **Child Benefit** in addition to Universal Credit: for 1 child – $\pounds 87$; 2 children - $\pounds 144$

National Insurance Number

If you are planning to work and not applying for Universal credit, you can apply for National Insurance Number here <u>https://www.gov.uk/apply-national-insurance-number</u> You will need your passport and Biometric Residence Permit (BPR)

Working in the UK

If you are planning to work, when you find a job, you'll need to prove your right to work in the UK. Here is a link to help you with that <u>https://www.gov.uk/prove-right-to-work</u>
